In December 2008, RLM Communications, Inc. was awarded a contract by the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center Charleston (SSC) as part of a multiple award vehicle, which was for the aggregate amount of \$51,481,983. These contracts include two one-year options, which if exercised, would bring the cumulative aggregate value of the contracts to \$157,778,069.

“As a rapidly growing SBA 8(a) and Service Disabled Veteran-Owned company, RLM’s new location will be easily accessible to contracting officers and can provide the expert services needed by potential customers,” said Randy Moore CEO/President of RLM. “To date our superior services and support has resulted in a high degree and measurable sense of loyalty between RLM and its customers.”

Construction of the RLM Communications, Inc. corporate headquarters and technical support unit in the Spring Lake Business and Industrial Center is the culmination of years of planning to fulfill a vision. This facility will enable RLM to provide its customers continued expert service and support in the areas of communications system integration, advanced technology research and development, training, logistics and contract program management.

In recognizing changing times, Mr. Moore further notes: “The military’s changing force and support structure is moving from soldier supported tasks to contractor outsourcing. As such, contracting processes are being streamlined for support of rapid deployment forces and contingency operations.
